

## Question and Answers about Summer Reading Program

**Do child/children have to be registered in the Summer Reading Program to receive a prize?**

**A: Every child must have a registration form on file to take part in collecting a prize for reading logs and end of the program prize.**

**How do I return registration forms?**

**A: Registration forms can be emailed to [info@bangorlibrary.org](mailto:info@bangorlibrary.org) or brought into the library and handed to a staff member.**

**Do you have to attend the programs on Thursdays to take part in the Summer Reading Program?**

**A: No, however you do need to have a registration form on file to take part in receiving prizes. **NOTE**, in order to attend the special program at the end of Summer Reading, you must attend at least 2 Thursday meetings.**

**Which age groups use which reading logs?**

**A: Patrons who are in Kindergarten to 3rd grade will use the picture reading log. Patrons who are in grades 4-6th will use the counting minutes log.**

**How do you record your reading progress on the paper reading logs?**

**A: For paper reading logs with pictures (used by Kindergarten-Gr. 3)-cross out one picture for every half hour of reading you do. You will receive one prize after you have 4 pictures crossed out (4 pictures= 2 hours). For Gr. 4-6<sup>th</sup> logs- write down the title of the book and the number of minutes that you read. You will receive on prize for every 2 hours that you read.**

**Does every participant receive a free book and a t-shirt throughout the Summer Reading Program?**

**A: All participants will be able to pick one free book with the completion of at least one reading logs and registration form on file. Participants will be able to pick a t-shirt with 3 completed reading logs and registration form on file. While supplies last.**

**When will all logs be collected?**

**A: All logs will be collected throughout the summer. Patrons can drop logs off at anytime.**

**What can I read?**

**A: You can read anything you want that would be appropriate for your reading level.**
